Then we had a few assisted tackles: one by Jalen Giles, Dow Jones, & Thomas Zatalava; another one by Andrew Goudeaux, Carter Malamphy, Thomas Zatalava, & Joshua Jones; and another from Carter Malamphy & Thomas Zatalava; and the last for the 1st half was by Kaemyn McAnulty & Dustin Flowers. On offense Jalen Giles started us off with a 10 yard carry, and followed that up with an 8 yard carry. Then Talon Alvarez took us out for a carry of another 10 yards.
