

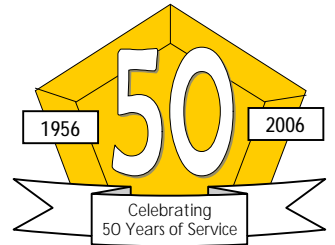

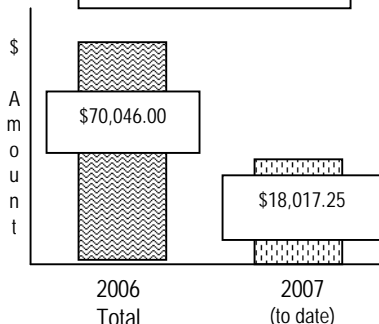
Construction Update
